

Ancient Roads

Report from Larry Labor: Larry Labor read the final report that goes to the state. Paul Hannon got his bill in on time and thus Larry was able to bill the state for the remaining portion of the grant. We stand \$1500 over expended waiting for the last reimbursement. The report and bill have been sent to the state.

Report of Allan Wooley: July 8th was the last day we could work. Allan finished filing for 70 roads, all with listing of road and discontinuances of such with all references to each road. Paul Hannon changed the map to 1" equal to 2000 ft. so these lined overlays of roads will fit on our present town maps. Allan has to yet consolidate his notes to place in the files as to how to locate the proper spot to place overlay. This info will be in each file of each road. Each overlay has a printed sheet of the overlay so that Allan can put notes on these sheets. None of these roads are unidentifiable. All have evidence in the area of the road. Allan showed us the map done to scale and one overlay with the ancient road on it and showed us how it fits on the map. – Road 9, we can't prove if it was really discontinued or only a portion discontinued. More work needs to be done to clarify what all has been done.

Where do we go from here? For the Select board deadline of our report to them is? We will need to have public meetings before one can either establish or throw-up any road. The meetings will need to be notified meetings of 45 days in advance. July 1st of 2015 is the end of time to identify any road as an old road or it will automatically be thrown-up.

We will need to bring the results to the Selectman by the end of October. Then the Selectmen take over to do what they will with the road or information of roads.
