**1. Call the meeting to order:**

A motion was made and seconded to call the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m.

**2. Review and approve minutes of October 10<sup>th</sup> 2017.**

A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of October 10<sup>th</sup> 2017 as written.

**3. To let any guests speak.**

All of the above engaged in a lengthy conversation about safety concerns and the access and development of the ATV trail off of Whitehill Loop and Bear Mountain Road. - c. Larry Labor asked TammyLee to look up the date of the first purchase of Landfill/recycling bags for the next meeting in anticipation of the need to do another order.
- d. The Town Shed on Jim Mcwains property will be removed by a group of the Amish. Questions came up about Liability if there were any damages or accidents and VLCT said that as long as the Town was not paying them there was accidental/damage coverage if a situation were to arise.
