Mrs. Kerr stated that she has gone to the Agency of Natural resources and explained the water problem and they stated that she had a case but could take up to 3 years in court to resolve.

The Board listened to the information and stated that this was not a town issue and that there was really nothing the Town could do and that authorities should be notified and record all instances and to maybe have a Lawyer write a letter to the offending neighbors seeking cooperation in resolving these issues.

They thanked the board for their input and said that they would let the Board know of any other instances that may arise just so that it is on record.
