

Selectboard Meeting Minutes

Monday March 24th 2025

5:00 p.m.

Present: Eric Pope- Chair of the Selectboard, Bruce Remick, Larry Labor

1. Call the meeting to order.

-Meeting called to order at 5pm

2. Review and approve the minutes of the March 10th meeting as written.

-Reviewed and approved.

3. Make any changes/additions to the draft agenda as needed.

- a. School Grease Trap: The Town hired Nadeau's Plumbing to replace a failed grease trap in the school kitchen. Since replacement, plumbing issues have arisen. Larry Labor will contact Nadeau's and have them assess and then fix the issue.
- b. Community House Project: Eric Pope recounted his conversation with Jesse Villeneuve, who has been awarded the contract to perform structural and drainage improvements to Community House. Jesse anticipates beginning work late spring or early fall and will be back in touch as soon as his schedule is more firm. Two events intended to be held this summer at the CH, may have to be relocated, but the CH committee will make that determination after the construction schedule is planned.
- c. NVDA visit: Eric shared the news that Alison Low and Cathlin Lord from NVDA will be joining the April 28th Selectboard meeting to discuss the National Flood Insurance Program as well as to begin planning for future updates to the Town Plan.
- d. Bridge 20: The Selectboard had a broad discussion regarding the bridge on Old Blake Farm Road that sustained damage during the July floods. It was decided that the best course of action was to have an engineer assess the site to determine structural integrity and hydraulic capacity in its current condition before going forward with the design of a new structure. After that evaluation

and discussions with FEMA, the Selectboard will decide whether to go forward with a replacement structure or to leave the bridge as is.
